



"Don't run!" He shouted.


Joe ran very fast to catch the robber.



As a matter of fact, many people in that area cannot get basic needs in their lives and the families are separated due to illnesses, death and some members have to leave home and work in big cities.

After this trip, I found that people in Hong Kong and the poor in China have very different lives. We have secure places to live. We can also get all basic necessities. However, we do not know what we have. For example, I always prepare more food than I need and so I waste a lot. I also blame my parents because we live in a small house and they force me to study hard. Actually I did not know about the lives of the poor until I visited the remote area of Yunnan. Now I know that they are worse off than me as many do not have any places to live and the family members cannot live together. Hong Kong is really a wonderful place to live. I can get what I want. The poor in Yunnan always live under fear. They have to struggle with hunger, poverty and bad weather.

The experience that I gained in Yunnan made me understand that we have to treasure what we have now. We have a good government that can provide education, welfare, medical services and housing to our citizens. As we are living in a well-developed city, we must help those in need, especially the ones in the developing countries. I think I will visit the poor in China or Africa in the coming summer.

At 6pm, there was a parade in Ocean Park. We thought it was very boring because it didn't have enough interesting things to show. We nearly fell asleep during the parade.


After the parade, we went home. Although I was high from all the excitement and fun I had today, I went to bed at once because I was tired.
